Guided Tour: Journey Through the History of Harley-Davidson

This guided tour will highlight the Harley-Davidson Journey galleries and provide a deeper insight into the history of the Motor Company. The tour will begin by telling the story of four young men who grew one of the most recognizable companies in the world from their kitchen table. The tour will also highlight some of the most significant motorcycles in the collection. The tour concludes by celebrating the most important aspect of the Harley-Davidson Motor Company—the people who ride them.

The tour is led by a Museum staff member and lasts approximately one hour. Guided tours are given on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays at 11:00 a.m. Groups may request a tour outside of the regularly scheduled tours, but reservations must be made 2 weeks in advance with the group tour scheduler.
